Within a week following the tour, participants will be called to get their feedback, advice, possible referrals to others and to explore potential involvement with the school. Those who are not interested in pursuing any further relationship with the school are thanked for attending the tour and not contacted again. The possibilities for those who might like to become involved with the school are many; some might want to volunteer at the school, others might like to partner in community service, others may want to support Desert Garden Montessori financially.

Those participants who have developed a relationship with the school will be invited to our annual free, breakfast fundraising event to be held in March.
